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How MEF distributes funds:

Every year we estimate fundraising, budget operating expenses, and provide support for teacher appreciation events, Project Grad, and Senior Breakfast.

The remaining funds all go to MHS projects through grants (40+%), technology committee, spring supply funding, and special projects. The MEF 2015-16 Budget includes \$18,500 total for fall and spring grants.

If the Crab Feed or donations exceed budget, we allocate those funds to MHS projects!

How MEF determines which grant requests are funded:

The MEF Grants Committee evaluates the applications on the following rubric. MEF grants should be the funding source of last resort. Please confirm that department funds, tech committee funds, etc. are not available prior to submitting application. MEF also encourages teachers to ask parents to donate for projects if they are able.

1. Enhanced Learning Process/Anticipated Impact (33%)
2. Number of Students Supported Directly or Indirectly (19%)
3. Period of Benefit to Students (14%)
4. Evaluation Plan in Place (14%)
5. Project Implementation Plan (10%)
6. Other Funding Sources Available (5%)
7. Number of Times MEF Funded in Past Years (5%)
