Papillion Landing Indoor Sports Rules

The recreational activity of participating in or viewing team sports games/practices at Papillion Landing involve an inherent risk of contracting COVID-19, and persons engaging in such activities assume that risk. To mitigate that risk of COVID-19, participants and spectators shall follow these rules:

Coaches and Spectators are required to wear a mask at all times.

Players are required to wear masks when not participating in a game/practice.

Temperature checks will take place upon entering our facilities.

Fan attendance is limited to two (2) household members of the players on a team. We recommend fans to keep six (6) feet of social distancing between groups of eight (8).

Spectator capacity is 75 people in the upper and lower spectator areas of the Field House (150 total), and 20 people on each side of each court in the Main Gym (120 total) and Community Gym (40 total).

Teams to play next must wait in an open area on the side of the court/field and wait until the other team(s) clears the court/field before starting warm ups.

Post-game handshakes or interaction between teams are prohibited.

When a game/practice end, teams must gather their items and leave the facility until their next game/practice.

Fans for an upcoming game must remain in their cars until the start time of a game/practice.

Players must bring their own water/beverage to consume during and after a game/practice. No shared water/beverages.

Players must bring their own snacks to consume during and after a game/practice. No shared/communal snacks.

Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized regularly while players and fans are present.

Remember to wash your hands thoroughly for twenty (20) seconds. Hand sanitizer will be available around the facility.

Coaches must sanitize shared equipment before and after each game/practice.

Concession stands will be open for games/tournament, please keep six (6) feet social distancing while in line.

Coaches/Tournament Staff are responsible for ensuring social distancing is maintained by players and spectators.
