Electronic Filing – Traffic Division

Effective May 19, 2014, the State Court of DeKalb County requires that certain case types be filed electronically.

The Traffic Division of the State Court of Dekalb County was created on July 1, 2015 and was excluded from any mandatory electronic filing requirements. In an attempt to provide all citizens of DeKalb County expanded access and fairness to the judicial process, the Traffic Division has implemented an electronic filing platform.

Currently the court accepts the following documents in the e-file portal:

1. Demand for a Jury Trial
2. Entry of Appearance
3. Leave of absence
4. Motion for Continuance
5. Notice of Conflict
6. Waiver of Arraignment/Not Guilty Plea

The electronic filing system allows an attorney, law firm, or pro se litigant to create an e-file account by going to the following link and registering with the Court. [Click here for E-File Registration](#)

Registration Instructions:

- Step 1 – Click on the [E-File Registration](#) Link
- Step 2 – Click “Register” on the left side bar
- Step 3 – Fill out all information available and create your unique Password
- Step 4 – Select Submit
- Step 5 – Your registration will be reviewed and approved by the court within 1-2 business days. Once approved, you will be able to log in and submit your new filings

Fines & Fees

The State Court of DeKalb County’s Traffic Division is granted jurisdiction by the Georgia Legislature over state law traffic violation cases committed in unincorporated DeKalb County.

Traffic violations carry fines with a maximum penalty of \$1,000 per charge. Georgia Law, also mandates additional surcharges ranging from 35-40% of the fine for designated local and statewide funds and programs. An additional \$25 court cost fee is imposed and authorized by Georgia law, along with a fee of \$50 if a defendant fails to appear in court.

Acceptable methods of payment include credit or debit cards and money orders. Personal checks or cash are not accepted during the Judicial Emergency Period.

If a Driver is under 21 years of age, on-line payments may not be processed before the court reviews the case and authorizes the payment due to a potential adverse impact on the Defendant's driving history. Please contact the court for further information.

Super Speeder

Under Georgia law, a 'Super Speeder' is defined as a driver convicted of speeding at 75 mph or more on a two-lane road or at 85 mph and above on any road or highway in the State of Georgia. Upon receiving notification of conviction, the Department of Drivers Service will send notice of a mandatory \$200 Super Speeder state fee to be paid by the convicted driver. Please note that the Super Speeder fee is separate from the fees paid to the Court. Failure to pay the Super Speeder fee within the time specified in the notice will result in the suspension of the offender's license or driving privileges and will further incur additional fees for license and license privileges reinstatement. Customer Letter

The DeKalb County State Court – Traffic Division developed the Online Case Resolution system during the Judicial Emergency period to offer motorists in DeKalb County the opportunity to safely resolve their traffic citations more quickly and efficiently online.

Instead of being limited to resolving citations on a pre-scheduled date and time to appear in court, individuals can access the DeKalb County State Court – Traffic Division using their smartphone, tablet, or computer at their convenience.

If you have been charged with a standing order violation and have corrected the issue, you may upload proof into the online portal. If approved by the court, you may pay a reduced fine or your citation may be administratively dismissed if required by law. All other Traffic violations will be reviewed by the court and a decision will be made as required by law.

Advisement Of Rights

Traffic Violations Bureau

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §40-13-50, a traffic violations bureau is established for the handling and disposition of certain traffic cases. This order governs state law traffic violation cases being heard at the State Court of DeKalb County Traffic Division located at 3630 Camp Circle, Decatur, GA 30032. Said division was created pursuant to HB 300 passed during the 2015 session of the Georgia General Assembly and signed into law by the Governor on March 3, 2015.

Failure to Appear (FTA)

If you missed an in-person court appearance prior to March 2020, or if you missed a virtual court date during the Judicial Emergency period, your case may be in FTA status. You are required to call the court at 404-294-2099, or email the court at dcscctinfo@dekalbcountyga.gov, to discuss your options to resolve your case; and or pay your citation. Motorists with FTA cases will not be able to pay fines on line until authorized by the court.
