



## **Mask Use on Our Campus**

*Updated July 30, 2021*

Mask use at St. John the Baptist depends upon your COVID vaccination status:

### **Unvaccinated? *Mask use required.***

SJB follows the **guidelines of the Diocese of Arizona**;

*"All unvaccinated individuals must wear masks at church."*

### **Fully Vaccinated? (2 weeks after final shot) *Mask use optional, but highly encouraged.***

SJB follows the **current guidelines of the Center for Disease Control**;

*"To maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading it to others, wear a mask indoors in public if you are in an area of substantial or high transmission."*
