Dear Y Member,

The health and safety of our members and staff is always our top priority. We have been and continue to closely work with and follow the Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA), California Department of Public Health (CDPH), the Center for Disease Control (CDC), and World Health Organization (WHO) for updates and directives regarding Covid-19 (Coronavirus).

At this time, based on the recommendation from the CDPH we have made the following decisions:

1. All gatherings where we cannot provide the recommended 6 feet of space will postponed.
2. All adult and youth sports leagues will be postponed.
3. All Adventure Guides events that gather over 250+ people and were scheduled for this weekend have been postponed. Any events that gather under 250 can still take place. We ask that all attendees that participate in any events follow precautionary steps and remain home if sick.
4. Active Older Adult Social Gatherings - all gatherings (i.e. potlucks) will be postponed until further notice.
5. Guest Passes & Shower Passes – will not be issued or redeemed effective immediately.
6. All classes will continue to operate, but with limited capacity.
7. New Horizons Program – all trips have been postponed. Social gatherings will be assessed on a case by case basis.
8. Third-party rentals: All currently scheduled rentals will be postponed and no new reservations will be taken at this time.

All other operations and programs will continue as planned. Should any new developments occur, we will notify all members promptly. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we all work to navigate this ever-changing situation.
