Normal teaching load includes nine credit hours per semester with a nine-month appointment. Supplemental summer appointments in teaching are also available.

Required:

- Ph.D. in Counseling from a CACREP-accredited program within a non-profit, traditional academic institution;
- Master's degree in Clinical Mental Health/Community or Addiction Counseling from a CACREP-accredited program within a non-profit, traditional academic institution;
- Clinical experience;
- Licensed Professional Counselor/equivalent and/or ability to attain full licensure in Michigan;
- Potential for or record of successful teaching and research for applicants for assistant professor;
- Demonstrated record of peer-reviewed publications and scholarly productivity, and a demonstrated record of teaching and more than five years in a tenure-track assistant professor position, or the attainment of associate professor for consideration of associate professor rank;
- Demonstrated commitment to social justice and advocacy.

Desired Qualifications:

- Significant clinical experience (five years or more) excluding practica and internship;
- Record of peer-reviewed publication(s) and/or other scholarly publishing;
- Experience working in an urban environment and with marginalized individuals.
