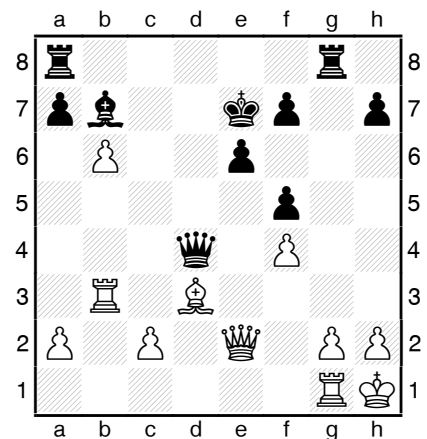

Ratings allow players to accurately compare their playing ability. The more tournament games a player has played the more accurate their rating becomes. It is also a good indication of how much a player has improved.

From now on the Victorian Junior Rating List will be published only 4 times a year. That being at the start of each school term. They will be published in this magazine. If you have the desire to know your rating between terms then please connect to the internet and find the current ratings on the Web.

All players who do not have their year of birth registered have been temporarily removed from the rating list. If you know that you have a rating but aren't on the list make sure you update your details with David at the next opportunity. You can, however, see your rating on the internet.

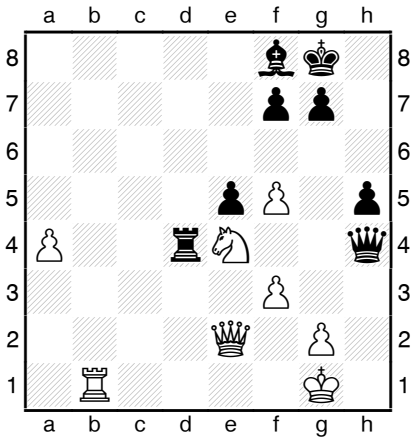

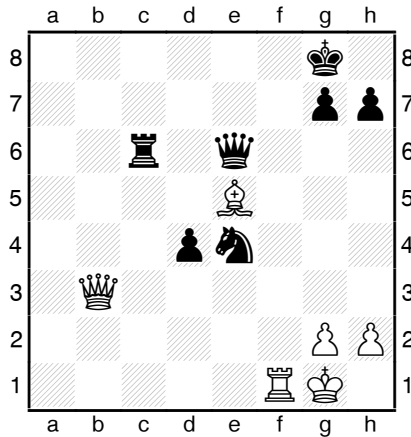

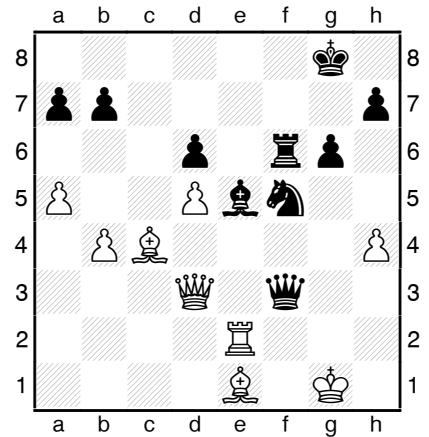

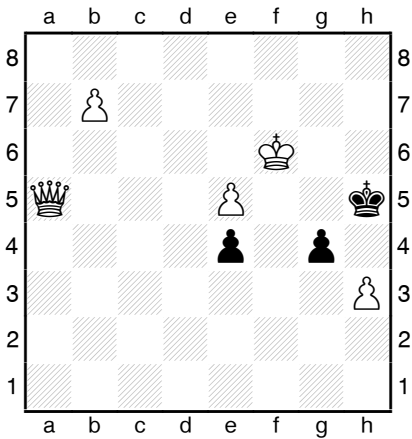

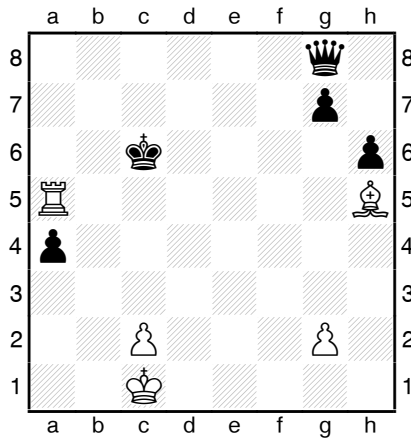

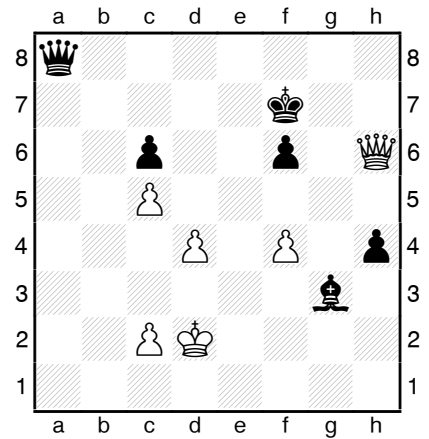
