

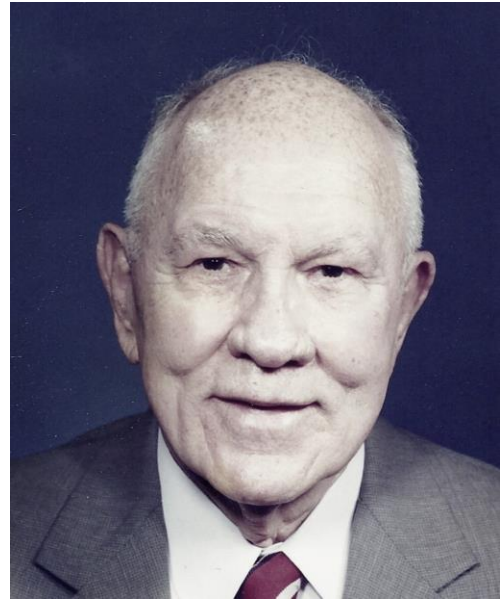
## Memorial Membership: Clarke Walden

31 Oct 1926 – 13 May 1999

Clarke Walden came from six generations of Georgians and was born in Macon, Georgia, 31 Oct 1926.

His patriot ancestor was Edward Davies, who was a member of the “rebel” Georgia Congress in 1780.

He attended Kings Point Merchant Marine Academy and the University of Florida Law School.



He served in the U.S. Merchant Marine Corps in 1944-1948 and as LTJG, U.S. Navy stationed in Japan during the Korean War. He settled in Dania, Florida after military service where he practiced law with his brother.

He was also City Attorney for the City of Dania from 1955 to 1975, General Counsel for the Dania Bank from 1955 to 1988, and as General Counsel for the South Broward Hospital District from 1988 to until his retirement in 1997.
