We are so grateful we get to resume in-person worship! Our first Sunday back will be Sunday, July 12th, 2020 at 11am. With this return, we are putting in as many safe-guards as possible so that we can be good stewards of each other's health! We ask for your participation in all of the changes we need to make so that everyone can be safe in worship together. For our complete policy, please check your email, go online to our church website at www.myaumc.org, go to our church facebook page, or call Rev. Jake to receive a copy of our full policy in paper! All of these recommendations are required by our Conference leadership in order for us to return to worship, we pray you will help us to follow these new guidelines so that we can all be safe together!

- 1. Entrants and exits will be clearly marked. Volunteers will be outside the building to help you to know which doors are unlocked and to give you a disposable mask if you need one!**
- 2. Wearing a mask is required at all times when you enter the building. Masks are required for everyone except children 2 and under. Masks will be provided if you do not have one you can bring.**
- 3. There will be no congregational singing allowed. Simply enjoy the music shared by Rebecca and Jessica and feel free to hum along with them if you would like!**
- 4. Please maintain 6 feet between you and everyone who you do not live in the same household with. Pews will be marked off to help maintain this social distancing.**
- 5. There will be no passing of the peace, and no greeting line with the pastor at the end of the service.**
- 6. Congregants will be dismissed at the end of the service by rows by the pastor, and you are asked to leave promptly out the marked exits.**
- 7. There will be sanitizing stations available for your use!**

If you do not feel comfortable attending church in person, online worship on our YouTube channel, Sundays at 11am will continue, please be sure to worship with us online! We will interact during the worship service with our online audience! Once again, we greatly thank you for participating in all that we need to do to make our worship space a safe place to be together!
