Parade packets will be available to pick up at the EpiCenter (3901 Brooke St.), as well as information published on the website (klamathsnowflake.com).

Parade Rules:

1. All entries must be decorated according to a winter, snowflake, or Christmas holiday theme. This year's parade theme is "**Christmas Around The World**".
2. No participant on the float may be dressed as Santa or Mrs. Claus. The Snowflake Festival Committee secures Santa and Mrs. Claus for the event.
3. If media crews approach you for a quick interview, please keep the floats moving in a slow manner. The parade must keep moving! Do not stop or perform maneuvers or routines that will slow it down.
4. Children under 12 **must** be inside moving vehicles or floats, and must be directly accompanied by an adult.
5. No Political, Religious and/or Commercial handbills please. No political entries will be accepted. Candy or favors (ie., flags, fans, etc.) may be handed out along the parade route, but throwing candy or favors is prohibited.
6. No FOR SALE signs are allowed on vehicles in the parade.
7. Limit of 2 vehicles per entry unless approved by the Snowflake Parade Committee.
8. All animals must be followed by a cleanup crew provided by your organization.
9. The parade is videotaped, and announcements are made near the intersection of S. 6th St. and Main St. No sirens, horns, or overly loud noises are allowed in this part of the parade.
10. This is a drug free, alcohol free, and smoke free event for participants AND spectators.
11. Applications for entries received after November 31st will be positioned at the end of the parade. Please try to have your information submitted before the deadline, so that we may place you properly in the line up. For any additional information, please go to www.klamathsnowflake.com.
