THANKSGIVING FUNDRAISER

Normally, in August each year, this center holds its only main fundraiser, "Burgerfest". Unfortunately, that wasn't the case this year. We have decided to make our Thanksgiving dinner our major fundraiser for this year and we are desperately asking for your support. Burgerfest brought in \$17,000 last year and in a normal year, most, if not all the food is donated by our food vendors. That won't be the case with our Thanksgiving Dinner. The meal will be on Friday, November 20 and will be a "drive through" only. There won't be any eating in the dining room and this is for everyone's safety. You will be able to drive through the portico in front and we will bring your meal to your car. This is open to all ages and the cost of the meal is \$10. We ask that you donate as much as you can, even if you choose not to enjoy the meal. The menu will be, turkey and dressing, mashed potatoes, gravy, green beans w/bacon & onions, whole kernel corn, cranberry sauce, white roll, fruit salad and pumpkin pie. We will need approximately 10 volunteers to help us on that day so if you are able to volunteer, please see Sherry or Dusty.

I'm sure you realize what being closed from March 17 to September 8 did to the finances of this center. Remember, we continued to send out over 200 meals per day to our meals on wheels clients and we continued to offer you drive through services. The program income that has to be generated by the center this year is \$200,000, so your support of this fundraiser is critical. Any donation you make to the Thanksgiving fundraiser is an investment in the continued growth of this center. This will be a reservation only meal and the last day to reserve your ticket is Monday, November 16.

- Tuesday, November 10, Violet Rage @ Danville. Van will leave at 8:30 a.m.

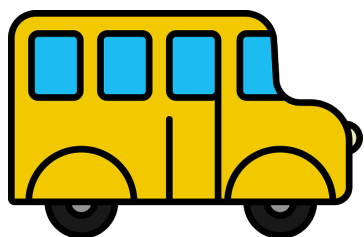
