

"My child fights each time we brush teeth, wash hair or have hair cuts. She does not like to get her hands messy and clothing labels bother her. She avoids climbing on outdoor equipment and is unusually sensitive to unexpected sounds in her environment. It seems difficult for her to focus her attention when she is in a noisy or busy environment. Shopping malls are a nightmare."

"I have noticed my son of 5 avoids drawing and other creative activities such as cutting and pasting tasks. He has a small table at home, with all the tools available, but shows no spontaneous interest in using these. If he is encouraged to draw a picture he tends to scribble and seems awkward when holding and manipulating the pencil."

"My son is easily dysregulated. His behavior escalates from zero to a hundred in a short space of time and he finds it very difficult to calm himself down again. It seems when he is anxious, his behaviors are worse and the reasons for these are not always clearly understood. He often gets into trouble at home and at school and this is affecting his self confidence and ability to engage with his peers as well as making it difficult for him to learn at school."
