A final reflection on the Rosary.

This Month of October is ending soon but the Rosary Devotion never comes to an end. Every month and every season of the year is a good time for our Rosary prayer. I pray that you have embraced this devotion and I pray others have come to love to pray the Rosary even more than before.

As much as I am expressing my wishes to you about the Rosary you may know that it really is our Holy Mother, the Heavenly Queen, the Mother of our Lord who has come to us from Heaven with her urgent appeals insisting that we need to pray this very powerful prayer.

Try to think of this idea. After our Blessed Mother fulfilled Her duties to God, Her life came to an end in this world and then she was miraculously taken up to Heaven with Her risen body and soul. You would think that Her Assumption would finally complete Her earthly mission.

But remember what happened when Her Son Jesus was dying on the Cross. He gave us His Mother to be our Mother. He made the human race for all time to be Her children. From Her lofty place in Heaven She sees everything and She can see the dangers coming to us. These many dangers do not have to conquer us and bring us terrible sufferings so She comes to us from Heaven so many times and it really is She who is urging us to pray the Rosary so that the enemy can be overcome. History tells us that this has worked so many times. The Rosary has many victory stories. And so we must be attentive to the voice of Mary our Mother and the messages She brings and we need to obey Her requests. Let us do what She tells us. Let us faithfully pray the Rosary every day.

For this last Rosary reflection I share with you one more mediation by Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI taken from the Fourth Glorious Mystery, the Assumption of Mary into Heaven.

The Heart of Heaven. Mary was taken up body and soul into heaven: there is even room in God for the body. Heaven is no longer a very remote sphere unknown to us. We have a mother in heaven. And the Mother of God, the Mother of the Son of God, is our Mother. He Himself has said so.

He made her our Mother when He said to the disciple and to all of us. "behold, your Mother!" We have a Mother in heaven. Heaven is open, heaven has a heart.
