

Health Protocols for In-Person Worship

General Information

- During this phase, the Sanctuary, the Fireside, the room next to the chapel and the restrooms will be open. Entry will be by way of the front door(s) on Marengo Ave.
- In-person worship attendance will be limited to the capacity allowed.
- All guests will be seated in marked seats and maintain three feet of social distancing.
- Restroom use will be limited to 1 person at a time.
- Childcare will remain closed at this time.
- Temperature will be taken upon entry with a no-contact temporal thermometer and hand sanitizers will be available for use.
- Masks will be encouraged for the safety of everyone present.
- If you have any of the following symptoms, we ask that you stay home/seek medical care:
 - Cough, sore throat, headache, loss of smell or taste,
 - Chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Diarrhea, fever or feverish
 - Close contact with a person who is confirmed to have COVID-19

We recommend that all who have an underlying at-risk health condition stay home and watch the services online. CDC recommends extra caution for those who are 65 and older.

Worship Services Protocol

- No one should shake hands. Instead, a wave and greet is recommended.
- Social distancing is required. Ushers will direct all guests to seats.
- Family members may sit together.
- Congregational singing will be limited.
- Please bring your Bibles as Church bibles and hymnals will not be available.

Facility Related Protocols

The church will:

- Regularly sanitize surfaces, such as doorknobs, tables, chairs, and restrooms.

- Disinfect any items that come into contact with attendees.
- Make hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, soap, or similar disinfectant available.
- Place readily visible signage to remind everyone of best hygiene practices.
- Kitchen and coffee and snacks will not be available.
- School parking will not be available.
- All seating in common areas will not be accessible.

Positive Test Protocols

If an attendee tests positive for Covid 19 within 1 week of attending:

- Attendee is asked to contact the Church.
- The Church will contact all those who were at the same event.
- Anyone exposed will be advised to monitor their health and we recommend they contact their physician for further instructions and recommendations.
