### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

**1. Applicant must be a senior in good standing and meet one of these four requirements: (check one)**

Attends Monomoy High School

Attends Cape Cod Regional Technical High School

Homeschooled Harwich resident

Harwich resident attending a private school

**4. Submit the following:**

Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher. The second letter should be from an individual with specific knowledge of your special talents and abilities in visual arts. They should address recent accomplishments, estimation of potential level of achievement, and your demonstrated willingness to work toward improvement.

A personal essay stating your plans for higher education, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship. Include information that would inform the GHA Scholarship Committee about you as an artist, and how art has influenced you as an individual.

**5. Prepare the following for scholarship committee review:**

A portfolio of 4 to 5 art pieces of your best work, presented in a professional manner: mounted, matted, wrapped, and signed. Identify each piece with a brief description, including medium used and motivations for doing it. Special consideration will be given to work done independent of the classroom.

**6. DEADLINE: Application, two letters of recommendation, and essay must be postmarked by April 1.**
