Who we are:

Street Children Ministry is an arm of the Methodist Mission in Cambodia run by General Board of Global Ministries missionaries.

Where we are:

Since 2001, the Ministry has been working in slums near the Tonle Bassac river, Daem Kor village, & the community living off the city Dumpsite.

In 2007, we expanded to work in New Phnom Penh.

Vision:

Our vision is to help create a world where marginalized people experience the love of God, love God, and are given opportunities to develop vocational skills and help them grow in Christ.

Mission:

Our mission is to share the Gospel and love of God by funding children's education, teaching vocational skills, and providing health care to the sick and undernourished.

Goals:

We strive to give hope to the hopeless, shine light to those in darkness, bring Christ to the poor, and share the love of God with all.

Education Programs



Since 2001, the Ministry has been working in slums near the tonle Bassac river, Bording community, CLCA Orphanage & Kien Kleang orphanage, Preak Torl UMC & the community living by the city Dumpsite. Since 2007 the Ministry expanded to work in New Phnom Penh & Torl Kok community living by the real way station . In each of these communities, education programs give students more chances to be intellectually stimulated each day, bringing opportunities
