**THIS WEEK'S  
MEMORY VERSE IS  
JOHN 13:14-15:**

"If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you."  
 John 13:14-15

**Work on committing this verse to memory and thinking about it this week.**

*Does Jesus want us to literally wash other people's feet? In what ways are we supposed to do what Jesus does in our love for others? What is one specific act of service you can do for someone else this week that would be loving them as Jesus does?*

**REVIEW TODAY'S MESSAGE BY DISCUSSING THESE QUESTIONS AS A FAMILY:**

1. Read John 13:1-17 together as a family. Retell the events of this passage in your own words. Where is this taking place? What is Jesus saying about Himself? How are people responding to what Jesus is saying and doing? How should we respond to what Jesus is saying?
2. Peter didn't want Jesus to wash his feet? Why not? How did Jesus respond? What was Jesus telling Peter? How do we need to be washed by Jesus? Why is this necessary?
3. The events of this week's passage (and the next few weeks' passages) take place during the meal we call the Last Supper. It was also the first celebration of Communion. We also celebrated Communion as a church this morning. Take some time to talk about what Communion is, who it is for, and why we should treat it with respect and special reverence. How does what we reflect on during Communion and today's passage go together?
