ITEM

DETENTION – DELAYS in LOADING and/or WAITING to LOAD or UNLOAD

Delays in loading, unloading and/or waiting to load or unload, when caused by shipper, consignee, or their representatives, will be charged for at \$ 69.65 per hour.

In disposing of fractions under this RULE, the following governs:

- 1 to 22 minutes ¼ hour
- 23 to 44 minutes ½ hour
- 45 to 74 minutes 1 hour
- 75 to 104 minutes 1½ hours
- 105 to 120 minutes 2 hours

- NOTE: A: Rates and charges for waiting time as shown above will apply ONLY after 7:00 A.M. and before 6:00 P.M. when the vehicle is held for the convenience of the shipper or the consignee through no fault of the carrier. (See Item 2756 for overtime loading or unloading).
- B: Where the shipment is moving 100 miles or less, the charges will be for waiting time ONLY as it exceeds one hour.
- C: Where the shipment is moving more than 100 miles, the charges will be for waiting time ONLY as it exceeds three (3) hours.

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EXPEDITED SERVICE

The term "Expedited Service" means service that requires specific dates for pick-up and delivery of shipments. Charges for such service are shown in this item.

Shippers who choose and are being charged for "Expedited Service" will be afforded preferential handling over any non-expedited service shipment loaded on the same vehicle. Additionally, if having more than one shipment loaded on the same vehicle compromises the carrier's ability to comply with a shipper's Expedited Service needs, apply rates in Item 2100.

All mileage based rates will be based on one-way, not round-trip miles.
