RULES AND OTHER PROVISIONS WHICH GOVERN THE TARIFF			ITEM

<u>Executive Order Requiring Social Distancing</u>	
<p>When a Global Pandemic or Governor’s Executive order requiring “social distancing” be issued that tariff participants charge the customer actual charges for mileage costs when employees must drive separately to a job site. This is being done for the safety of employees and to meet the social distancing requirements. Tariff participants charge 0.56 cents per mile from terminal to origin to destination to terminal using google maps to calculate the mileage distance. Rates are charged according to the GSA approved rates.</p> <p>When a Global Pandemic or Governor’s Executive order requiring “social distancing” be issued that tariff participants charge the customer a personal protective equipment (PPE) surcharge, such as gloves, masks, soap, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes. It will apply at the rate of \$5 per employee working on the customer’s job. Gloves and masks are one-time use and will be supplied by the carrier for each move.</p> <p>This will expire when the Executive Order expires, is not extended, or is repealed.</p>	<p>990</p> <p>◆</p>
