Most often, advance planning makes visits more affordable.

- Share travel/lodging expenses with other schools in your district or neighboring district and/or team up with a local library, bookstore, or museum.
- Apply for the [Amber Brown Grant](#) through the Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators (SCBWI). One school is selected each year to receive an all-expense paid author/illustrator visit.
- Check your local arts council or education council for available grants. Please contact me if you are writing a grant and need assistance.
- Offset the cost with a book sale through your PTO. Or many indie bookstores will help coordinate a sale that will serve as a fundraiser for your school.
- Take advantage of a regional book festival, reading association conference, SCBWI conference, or other event in your area where I am already speaking. Find out if I'm attending and contact me ahead of time so I can make a stop at your school while I'm in the area or traveling through. I am happy to arrive early or stay late and visit!
