RE: Deutsches Haus – Zoning Docket 067/14

To Whom It May Concern,

In February of this year, the Deutsches Haus made a presentation to the Faubourg St. John Neighborhood Association as part of their NPP requirements. We understood that the sale of alcohol would be included as part of the operation of the Deustches Haus. There was not vote at that particular meeting, but there was general support by the Board members and guests.

This past week, the Faubourg St. John Neighborhood Association had its July Monthly Board meeting on Monday July 14th. At that meeting, a presentation was made by our zoning committee pertaining to the request by the Deustches Haus. Part of that presentation included a survey that was passed out among residents in a 300' radius.

We received the surveys back with 75% in support of the conditional use permit. After the presentation was complete, a motion was made, and passed unanimously to support the Deutsches Haus' request. Our neighborhood is in support of the conditional use permit for the relocation of the Deutsches Haus to Moss St. and do not request any specific provisos to be included as part of it. I hope that you will include this letter as part of your file for the CPC Hearing on July 22, 2014.
