## SLEEPY HOLLOW CEMETERY TREES IDENTIFIED

The Friends of Sleepy Hollow Cemetery, Inc., a long-established volunteer local organization whose Mission is the continuing beautification and enhancement of and education about Sleepy Hollow Cemetery, announces that another successful project in the Cemetery has been completed.

Collaborating with the Town's Cemetery Committee, the Cemetery Supervisor, and the administration of the Department of Public Works Division of Highways and Grounds, The Friends designed and funded the permanent signage for the 25 indigenous Massachusetts trees - 24 of which are located in Sleepy Hollow, and one in Old Hill Burying Ground.

Commenting on behalf of the Board of Directors, President Kevin Thomas Plodzik remarked that "this project was one that had long interested The Friends, and we are very pleased in its realization. It could not have been occurred without the expressed support of the Cemetery Committee and the work of the Cemetery and Highways and Grounds professionals, who carried out extensive research and were responsible for the installation of the signs. One tree of each designated species is now so marked for easy identification. In addition, we are truly grateful to our generous donors without whom our many other accomplished projects in the Cemetery like gate entrance signs and maps, granite benches, descriptive marker at the renovated Melvin Memorial, and others, could not have taken place."
