OUTDOOR BOULDER PARK RULES

- Everyone using the Outdoor Boulder Park (OBP) must first sign a “Boulder Park Release of Liability, Waiver and Assumption of Risk” in addition to the standard Granite Arch Climbing Center “Release of Liability, Waiver and Assumption of Risk.” **If you are under 18 years of age, your parent or legal guardian must also sign.**
- Only Granite Arch members and their guests are permitted to use the OBP.
- Direct adult supervision is required for children under 14 years of age at all times while using the OBP.
- Smoking is not permitted in the OBP.
- **CRASH PADS MUST BE USED AT ALL TIMES** in the OBP unless you are traversing.
- If you are traversing, your feet must not exceed three (3) feet above the ground immediately below you.
- A spotter is required at all times (unless you are traversing).
- **DO NOT STAY OR “HANG OUT” ON TOP OF THE BOULDER FOR ANY REASON.** If you top out you must immediately down climb using the ladder on the freeway side of the boulder. Use caution when using the ladder.
- Be alert for the presence of insects, bees, wasps and spiders when using the OBP. Remember you are climbing outdoors.

Granite Arch Climbing Center reserves the right to restrict or deny access to the boulder park to anyone who violates any of these rules or climbs in a reckless manner which endangers themselves or others.
