

Hiller Highlands Four Association Board of Directors Executive Session Meeting, Monday, April 23, 2018, Highlands Country Club

The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. by President Toulia Victor. Board members present were Treasurer Walter Schindler and Secretary Will Mies. Committee Chair-Parking Hal Teasedale was also present. Guests attending were Gordon Seligson, Clipper Hill 6 resident and his attorney Frank McKeown.

The topic of the meeting was to discuss the vandalism incident involving the cutting down of a tree in front of 7CH on Sunday afternoon April 8 by a person using a machete or hatchet and to express concern of the board and neighbors about the issue of public safety. Gordon said that a guest living in his house has admitted to cutting down the tree, which followed a series of parking violations involving her truck. Two police reports were filed about the incident, a 911 call and written report, but so far there has been no response from the Oakland Police Department. Gordon said that he is in the process of eventually selling his house, but could not commit to a definite timeframe when this would happen. The Board has directed its attorney to draft a warning letter to Gordon, stressing the neighbors' concerns about public safety and how the situation involving the guest cannot continue indefinitely.
