Waterton Lakes National Park Calgary, AB

Waterton Lakes National Park is an international peace park and the smallest national park in the Rockies. The park covers an area of 505 square kilometers and is the only Canadian National Park to preserve the foothills fescue grasslands.

Project Design Brief

Conservation specialists working at the Waterton Lakes National Park in Calgary, discovered that the roadways were a hazard to the endangered salamanders natural habitat. The salamanders migratory paths crossed the roadways and during migration, many were being killed as they crossed the roadways. A tunnel system was built into the road complex around the park to allow the Salamanders safe passage beneath the road.

Benefits

- ACO Wildlife recycled plastic, tunnel entrance and fence systems were used to guide the Salamanders into the tunnels.
- The AT500 is an 18" wide tunnel that is rated to load class D to ensure the safety to both salamanders and drivers.
