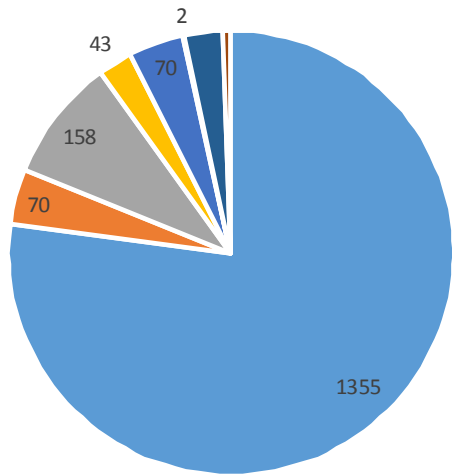

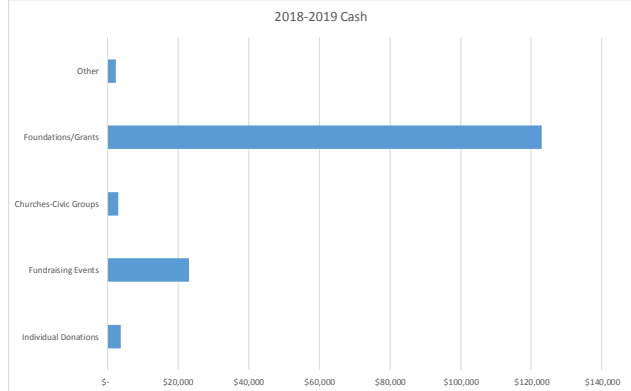

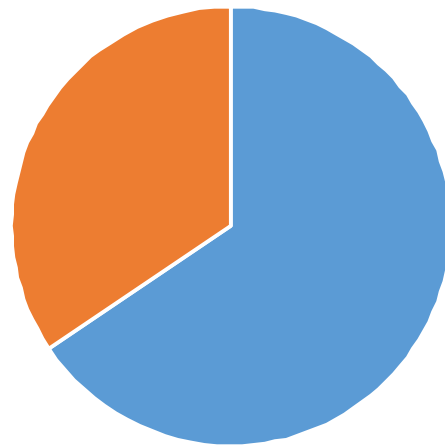


INCOME and EXPENSES
