

COVID-19 Regulations

As we prepare for the start of Camp Sviva 2020 during these challenging times, we are continuously monitoring the situation in regard to the rates of COVID-19 cases throughout the United States and Canada. As infection rates spike in many areas, we must adjust our requirements and plans accordingly. Since the situation is so fluid, however, we cannot say for certain whether or not it will have to be adjusted again closer to arrival time.

As of now, the plan is as follows:

- If you have tested positive for antibodies, you do not need to test any further. Submit your positive antibody test to Svivasleepaway@gmail.com.
- Every camper, staff member and administration member coming in for the session who does not have antibodies must be tested at least a week before camp for COVID-19, and must submit a negative result **BEFORE THEY LEAVE TO COME TO CAMP**.
- Be sure to isolate from the time of the test until the start of camp.
- We may or may not retest the girls when they come into camp. This will have to be determined closer to the start of camp and will be based on the rates of infection in different areas. If it is determined that they must be retested, you will be assessed a \$40 charge for the test.

FAQs

My daughter is away at another camp for the first session and they are also in a “bubble”. Do I have to have her test again before coming to Camp Sviva?

Yes. You cannot come to Camp Sviva until you have been re-tested. You must submit negative results before you leave to come to Camp Sviva.

I do not have time between the end of my first camp and the start of Camp Sviva to test before I come. What should I do?

We cannot make an exception for anyone. If your daughter is in another camp for the 1st session, you must either bring her home early from the first trip or she will have to come late to the second trip. Please plan accordingly.

The lab in my area is backlogged and results take a long time to get. What will happen if I do not get the results in time?

If your results do not arrive on time you will have to wait until you have them and come to camp late. You may not enter the premises unless we have your results. We do not want to have to turn anyone away at the gate. Please do not leave to come to camp until you have your results. To avoid this issue, call your lab right away to find out how long it will take to get results and make sure to test early enough.

I am flying in from out of town. When must I arrive?

If flying in from out of town, please arrive with enough time to quarantine for 3 days upon arrival, then take a COVID test, and then get the results before driving to camp. There are rapid tests available in some areas, (For example, in Lakewood NJ: Friendly Urgent Care 732-385-6820), but make sure to determine availability before you finalize your plans.

I am driving in from out of town. Must I still arrive early?

If you are driving in, you can take a COVID test in your hometown with enough time to get the results before you leave to come to camp. You must self-isolate from the time of the test until camp. When you stop at rest areas on the way, you must wear a mask and wash your hands thoroughly when you get back into the car.

COVID-19 Medical History

Camp Sviva is implementing measures to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 and the related PMIS disease within camp, including requirements of antibody and PCR testing, daily monitoring and frequent cleaning and disinfection. We are aware, however, there is the possibility of infection with COVID-19. We are asking each person attending Camp Sviva to complete the following form, indicating that, based on the medical history of that individual, it is not likely that this person will have an unusually adverse reaction to the contagious COVID19. We understand that this is no guarantee of each individual's reaction to the virus, should someone chas v'shalom become infected.
