2017 MAHANA SYRAH



Like a stunning Walla Walla Valley sunset, Mahana Syrah is a complex, lavish expression from the Rocks District of Milton-Freewater.

Named after Mr. Mahana, who established the sister city to Milton in 1889, this Syrah, Viognier co-fermentation is marked by notes of cured meat, olive tapenade and leather.

Aged in large format new oak barrels, a glass of this wine complements the colors of a summer evening spent with friends.

"Lastly, the 2017 Mahana was fermented in concrete tanks. It has more bright blue fruits, spring flowers, spice and incense on the nose. These carry to the palate, where the wine is medium to full-bodied, fruit-forward yet concentrated, balanced and elegant. It's another terrific wine that can be drunk today or cellared for at least a decade."
