1. If Jesus loved Lazarus, why did He wait two days before going to help him?
2. What does John 11:15 tell you about Jesus' purpose?
3. Do you believe Martha had faith, doubt, or a mixture of both? Do you think that's OK?
4. Do you see any evidence of Jesus' love for His family in this passage?
5. Jesus obviously knew how things would turn out, so why was He so deeply moved by Martha and Mary's grief?
6. If you were a disciple and you saw Jesus raise Lazarus from the dead, how would you have responded?
7. Have you ever felt abandoned by God in a time of need? What does this story tell us about those feelings?
8. Someone once said, "We don't always know all of God's purposes, but we can always trust in His character" Do you agree? Why or Why not?
9. How does knowing the power of Jesus to raise the dead impact the way you live your life?
