THE BASICS

We are excited to provide a plan for distance learning support to working families in both Tarrant and Parker counties. You will be able to choose a schedule of 2,3, or 5 days a week.

Days & Times

Beginning August 24th

There is a 30 minute window for pick up and drop-off (8:30am-3:00pm daily)

MWF 9:00-3:00

TTH 9:00-3:00

Pricing Per Week

MWF: \$200 (\$110 for additional children in same family)

TTh: \$130 (\$75 for additional children in same family)

M-F: \$ 300 (\$150 for additional children in same family)

THE DETAILS

- Masks will be optional, and we will encourage social distancing
- Learning pods will be separated by grades with 1 teacher for 5-6 children at a time
- Distance learning children will be separated from drop-ins
- We will have one teacher assigned to each group along with an aid
- All newly contracted teachers have had previous experience as a teacher, tutor, or are currently studying early childhood education
- Parents provide tablet/laptop and headphones
- There will be contracted teachers who provide specials including: science, music, yoga, art, reading just to mention a few
- Scheduled routine including built in time for play based learning as well as opportunities for group interaction and problem solving
- Will not have access to video games or television throughout the day
- You have the option to leave your kiddo(s) longer than the allotted time, at our hourly rate
- Snacks are provided, lunch may be purchased or brought from home *no nut products

THE REST

School age children who attend TPS as a drop-in are able to bring their work (tablet/computer) however they will not receive the same one to one support as the children enrolled in our learning pod program
