**Distribution of Holy Communion** – As we continue our reawakening processes across the Diocese, Holy Communion here, too, at the Cathedral will once again be distributed under two forms, the Body and the Most Precious Blood of our Lord. Recipients of the Sacrament will continue to proceed single file down the center aisle to receive the Body and the Blood standing before the celebrant as we do now. We will begin our administration of the Holy Eucharist by this means on the first Sunday of Advent, November 28th at all three of our Masses.

**Wreaths Across America** – On **Saturday, December 18, 2021 at noon** a wreath-laying ceremony will be held at our cemetery on Kane Street in conjunction with one occurring at Arlington National Cemetery as well as more than 2,500 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea and abroad.
