All about Muggsy Bogues

Muggsy Bogues is a former NBA star who was born in 1965 in the Lafayette public housing projects of Baltimore, Maryland.

Beating the odds, Muggsy became known for his accomplishments in basketball despite the challenges he faced growing up in public housing and being only 5'3" tall.

At his alma maters – Dunbar High School in Baltimore and Wake Forest University in Winston-Salem – Muggsy proved that he could beat all odds.

Wanting to share his good fortune of overcoming hardships and obstacles and embracing his philosophy of “always believe,” Muggsy established the Muggsy Bogues Family Foundation in 2019.



History of the MBFF

Muggsy began his philanthropic efforts by establishing Always Believe, Inc. in 2013. The mission was to provide a safe place for at-risk youth, ages 12-18, to excel and motivate them to achieve their dreams.

When Muggsy's mother passed away, he decided to close the nonprofit. His daughter inspired him to relaunch it in 2017.

After supporting tutoring and afterschool programs with over 1,000 students served, Muggsy wanted to shift his focus to align with a more holistic approach to reach not only at-risk youth but the entire family unit as well.

In 2019, Muggsy renamed his nonprofit the Muggsy Bogues Family Foundation. The mission now focuses on helping at-risk youth and families struggling to find their way to economic and family stability by addressing issues of education, job training and food insecurity.



Initiatives of the MBFF

Muggsy Bogues Family Scholarship Fund: a scholarship program for eligible students enrolled in skilled trade programs at CPCC. The MBFF partners with the CPCC Foundation to administer scholarships to income-eligible students.

Labor of Love: a food distribution program for at-risk families held on Labor Day to provide home-cooked meals and other basic necessities such as water, school supplies and hygiene products. In 2020, the MBFF partnered with Pineville Neighbors Place and Goodwill Industries.

Holiday Labor of Love: a food distribution program for at-risk families held during the holiday season (December) to provide pantry boxes, restaurant gift cards and other basic necessities such as water and hygiene products. In 2020, the MBFF partnered with Mecklenburg County, Harvest Center of Charlotte, Mental Health America of Central Carolinas, Charlotte Rescue Mission Dove's Nest, and the Salvation Army Center of Hope.

Mobile Food / Job Training Initiative: in collaboration with Goodwill Industries, an eight-week, cohort-based program where eligible individuals enter job training at Goodwill while receiving meal kits from the MBFF is being developed. This program will allow eligible individuals to receive job training while reducing worries about meals.
