put all of your eggs in one basket," he warned.

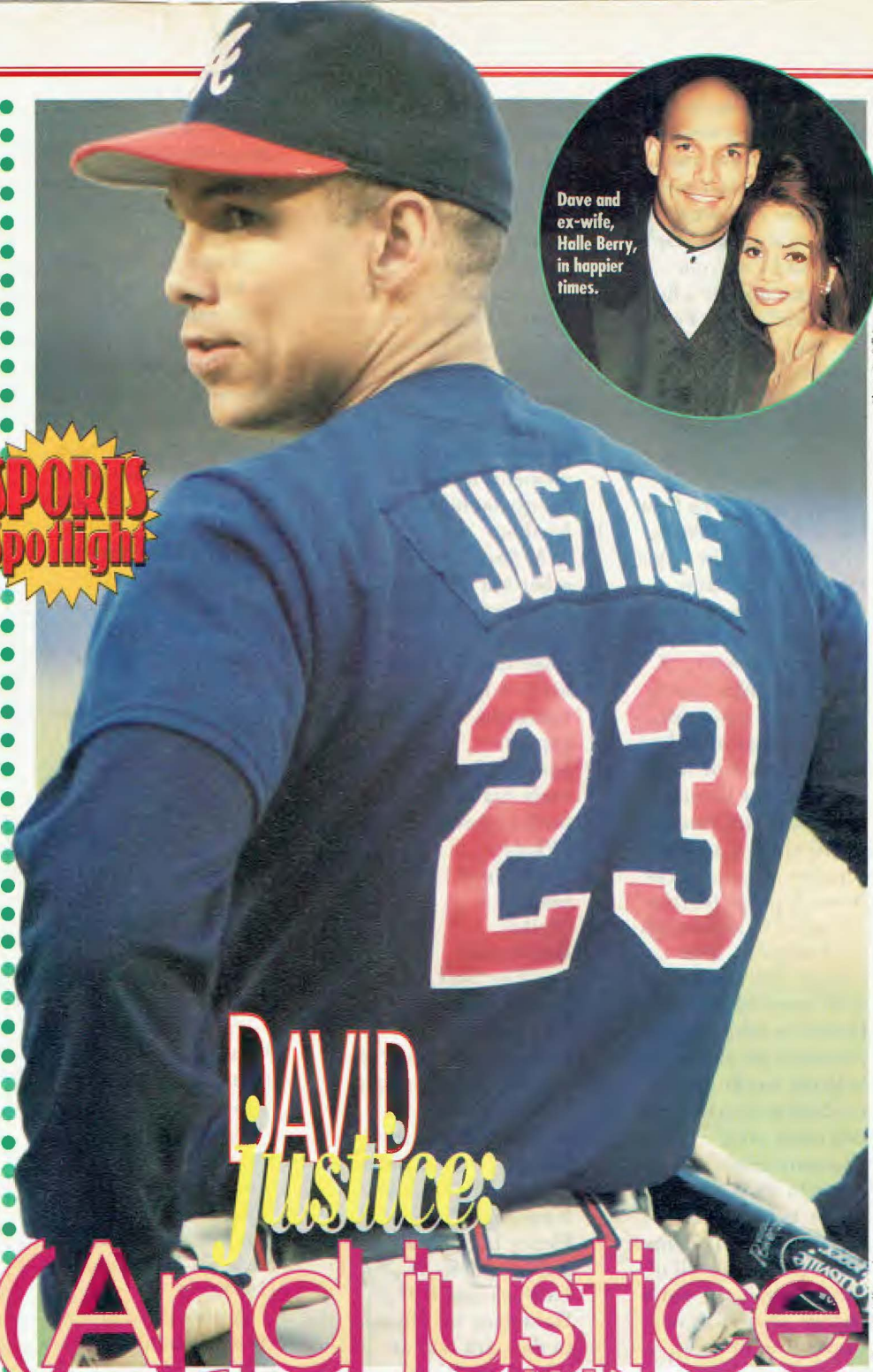
Not one to be labeled as all talk, Justice put his time where his mouth is, while in
