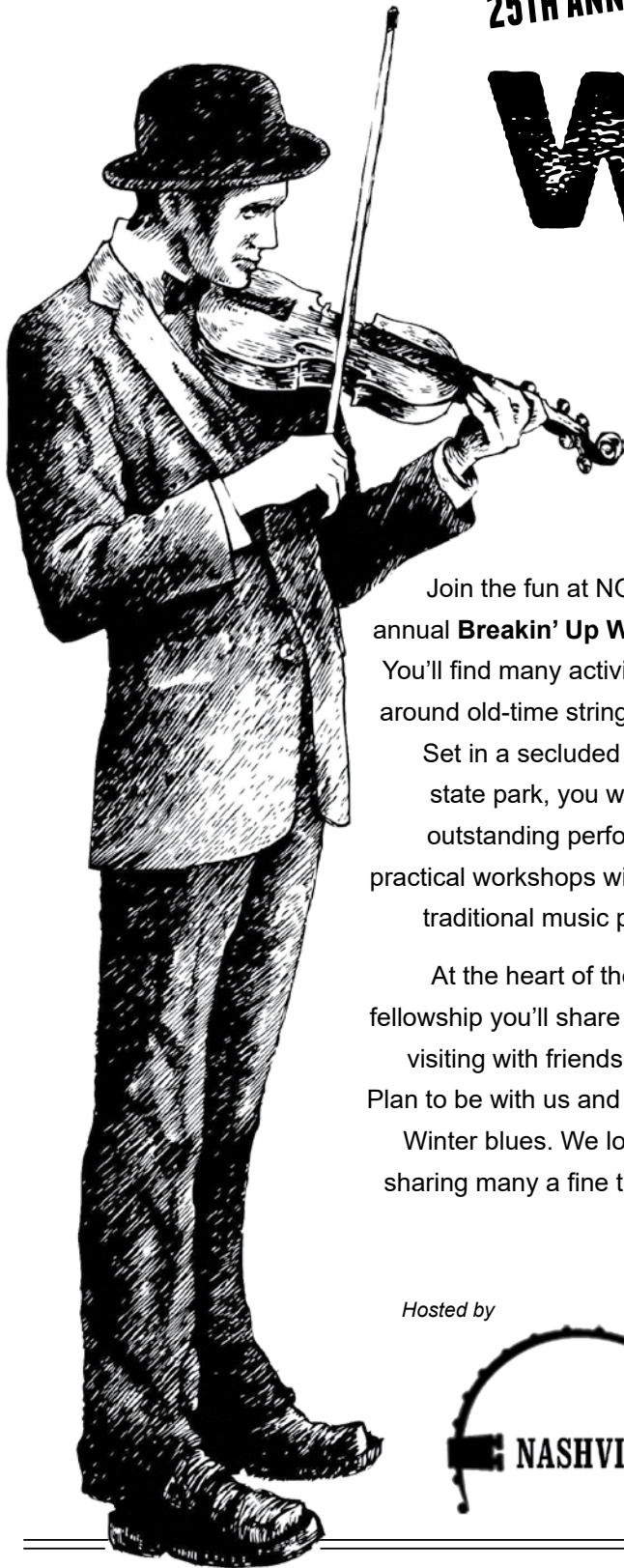

LOCATION

Cedars of Lebanon State Park, Lebanon, TN, 30 miles east of Nashville.

LODGING

Group Lodge: Two big bunk rooms – one for night owls, one for early birds. Bunks are not pre-assigned and rooms are not gender specific (bathrooms and showers are). Bring bedding, towels and earplugs.

Camping: RV and tent camping are available. Call the Cedars of Lebanon park office at 615-443-2769 to reserve your spot.

Local Motels: Lebanon, TN, 7 miles north of the park, has several motels. EconoLodge and Holiday Inn Express & Suites are nearby.

Cabins: There are few cabins available and many who want them, so we hold a drawing to level the playing field. A cabin sleeps 5, Thurs/Fri/Sat nights. Kitchens have cookware; linens included. The postmark deadline for entry is January 11. We email results to applicants soon after the drawing on January 16; if you don't initially get a cabin, we can either tear up your \$500 check or put you on a waiting list.

IMPORTANT: We do require registration (mail-in or online) for the full weekend before a cabin entry is considered valid.

2020 PRESENTERS & PERFORMERS

Frank & Allie Lee with The Freight Hoppers

Frank and Allie Lee are a vocal-driven old-time duo based in Bryson City, North Carolina. Frank (guitar/banjo/resonator guitar) has impressed audiences all over the US, Canada, and northern Europe with his signature clawhammer sound. Allie (guitar/banjo/harmonica) is a founding member of The Whipstitch Sallies, a band from Indiana that toured in the Midwest, North Carolina, Colorado, and Hawaii. Frank and Allie are bringing their band **The Freight Hoppers**; Frank is a founding member of this rollicking string band formed in 1992. Their repertoire includes music first recorded in the late 20s and early 30s, spanning geographically from Mississippi to West Virginia. Other members include fiddler **David Bass** and **Amanda Jean Kowalski** on upright bass.

Charlie Walden & Patt Plunket

Charlie Walden and Patt Plunket (aka Patt & Possum) are active contra and square dance musicians from Missouri. They both grew up listening to and playing traditional mid-western fiddle music, learned at the feet of some of Missouri's finest old time fiddlers. Award-winning Charlie on fiddle and Patt on piano are in demand as instructors at music camps, teaching fiddle, piano styles, traditional dance and vocal music. Patt is a professional music educator and trained singer; her natural ability as a dancer led her to take an interest in square and contra dance calling and instruction, along with clogging and step dance.

Shad Cobb & Jenny Obert

Shad Cobb & Jenny Obert are award-winning fiddlers and vocalists from Middle Tennessee; Shad's a first-rate clawhammer banjo player as well. Both are experienced touring and recording professionals seen on stages, festivals and studios worldwide, from the Grand Ole Opry to Europe, and are highly regarded instructors.
