Safety Tip of the Month - April 2006

#### **PROPER BRAKING**

Proper braking takes practice. Maximum stopping power is achieved when maximum force is applied to both brakes simultaneously without locking either wheel. Remember, the front brake can provide seventy percent or more of the total power in braking. Proper maintenance of the braking system and working on your skills to shorten total stopping distance just may lengthen your stay here on earth!

# MDA TUB RUN UPDATE

Hey Everyone!

Tick-tock! Tick-tock! You hear that? That's the clock moving forward! As of today (March 15<sup>th</sup>), there are only 93 days before the Tub Run is here! Where did the time go? Before you know it, we'll be busy setting up the park and getting ready for the huge mass of people that will be coming to the third largest fund raiser in the country for MDA in the Harley Davidson Corporation. I just want to let you know what the committee is up to and some of the changes for this year's event.

Something new this year! The top fund-raiser will not automatically get the incentive prize (yet to be determined). This year, the name of every person who pledges \$500.00 at registration will get their name put into a bucket. If you turn in \$1,000.00 in pledges, your name gets put in twice. If you collect \$2,000.00 in pledges, your name would be in the bucket four times. Get the idea? If you turn in, say, \$755.00 in pledges, your name will go in once. The amount will be rounded down, not up. We will draw one name from that bucket out at the park Saturday evening, and that person will receive the incentive prize. We're still meeting with the city working out the details. If all goes well, I should be able to let you know the mystery city at the April meeting. That is if I have my bird by then.
