It is June, and we will have heavy summer rain storms, wind, and often LIGHTNING! This is very common in many parts of the United States, and even in your own backyard. You would be smart to be wary of lightning when riding a motorcycle. Those rubber tires won't insulate your body from a lightning strike, and your head makes a pretty good lightning rod. The odds aren't good riding in a thunderstorm. You'll usually know when you are riding into a dangerous situation, so the trick is to know when to take a break. If it is suddenly raining hard, you hear thunder just a few seconds away, GET OFF THE BIKE AND UNDER COVER until it quits booming. Usually a thunderstorm moves on within a half hour or so. By "UNDERCOVER", I don't mean just standing under a tree, because trees can direct the bolt right down to the ground. Preferably, get inside a CLOSED BUILDING, or inside a metal vehicle. If there is no other structure between you and the lightning, at the very least, duck under an overpass. And remember that you can usually turn around and retreat a few miles to find shelter if necessary.

LIGHTNING IS SERIOUS STUFF. Recently a motorcyclist was struck by lightning in Dane county and killed – right here where we live and ride. Ride smart, ride safe. Your Safety Officers, Michael Fagan and Michael Borgwardt want you to have a great riding season, the safety part is up to you.
