One million H.O.G. patches stacked atop one another would rise approximately 8,300 feet – a little higher than Craig Pass (elevation: 8,262 feet) in Yellowstone National Park.

## **Safety Officers----*Mike Fagan & Mike Borgwardt***

**DID YOU KNOW.....JUNE IS MOTORCYCLE SAFETY MONTH?**

**\*Well it is, and so is every month that we are riding our motorcycles!**

The majority of motorcycle accidents are collisions with passenger cars at URBAN intersections. Although there are many potential hazards at the intersection, the LEFT -TURNING CAR is your major concern! THE MOST FREQUENT OF ALL MOTORCYCLE/AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENTS ARE COLLISIONS WITH LEFT-TURNERS. You should have predicted that the car ahead might turn left in

front of you, and reduced speed by shifting down and applying a little front brake. Slowing just 10 mph reduces your stopping distance almost in HALF, and covering the brake lever reduces the reaction time. Once you have slowed, keep an eye on the car in case you have to change position or stop quickly. Make eye contact as soon as possible, where they are looking is where they are going!

June 17th is this year's MDA TUB RUN. Watch for LEFT-TURNERS who might be in a hurry and want to cut thru a gap in the group ride!

Ride SAFE and be cautious! Divers talking on cell phones is one more potential distraction that you must deal with!

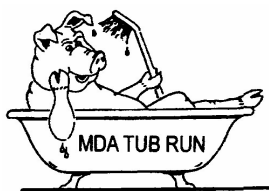

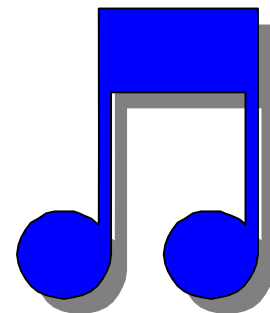
