September brings us the beginning of our most beautiful riding season, but not without risk, danger and incidences that are unsafe. You are out for a leasurely ride and as you exit one corner, you see a dark line on the road surface ahead running up the middle of your lane. You immediately identify it as oil, so you slow and move to the left where the pavement is clear. You continue your ride, but at a reduced pace, hoping the oily line will soon end so you can resume your spirited pace. It becomes unavoidable that you will have to ride over it and the road ahead also becomes a curve. You use your experience(?) and try to straighten your motorcycle before crossing over the oily surface, but as soon as you press on the handlebars to turn, the front tire slips and your bike immediately falls onto its side.

Thankfully, you are okay. Unfortunately, you didn't accurately assess just how hazardous the situation was. This is a tough call EVERYTIME and after a dry month like this August we have plenty of oil drippings on our highways which when mixed with water will become slippery as well. Pay special attention to the condition of your riding road surfaces and contamination that may be on it, we want you to have a safe and wonderful fall riding season. No cell phones (only for an emergency), no GPS, and no OnStar. We started in Jefferson Friday morning at 8:00 am, traveled over 750 miles in the Envoy and ended up at the Jefferson High School Sunday afternoon about 2:30. We had an absolute blast doing this.

Tomorrows Hope also has an event called "Ride with a Buddy". That's where you pay \$20.00, register, and then go on about a 50 mile ride, about an hour, giving a cancer survivor, or someone who lost a loved one to an illness, or someone who is currently battling an illness, a ride on the back of your bike, or in your classic car. Jes, Jenny and I went on the ride last night at the Jefferson County fair grounds. It was a police escorted ride with the intersections blocked like we do for the Tub Run. Jenny stayed at the fair grounds so I could give Rosie a ride. She was this elderly lady that lost her husband of 52 years to cancer nine years ago. She really enjoyed the ride. She was laughing, waving at people and kicking back taking in the scenery. During the ride she said that she now knows why people enjoy riding motorcycles so much. We got back to the fair grounds and Jenny said she was smiling ear to ear. We got off the bike and Rosie gave me the biggest hug I think I've ever gotten before. Rosie and I have a date for next year already. We need to talk people. I think this event would be a good fit for our Chapter.

Sorry I rambled on so, but that shouldn't be any surprise to you that know me. I'll end this article thinking of the word September! Three things just popped into my head when I wrote that word. Hunting, Packer football, and chaps in the morning on the way to work! We're coming into some of the best riding of the year in Wisconsin.
