After you've joined, you will receive a LOH embroidered patch and a LOH pin each year, in addition to the annual H.O.G. patch and pin.*

*Remember **LOH** is not about where you ride on the bike – it's about ladies sharing their common passion for Harley-Davidson Motorcycles.*

Hi fellow riders and chapter members! We have discussed the H.O.G. Ride 365 program over the past several months in our chapter meetings and I would like everyone to be aware of this exciting opportunity.

Here's the breakdown of the program:

It's a mileage recognition and reward program available to all H.O.G. members, both riders and passengers! To get started, mileage must be read and entered at our dealership, by dealership employees. While I don't expect any of you to ride your bikes to the dealership during these bitterly cold, slippery and salty conditions, I do encourage you to stop by the dealership on your first day out riding this year to get your mileage read and recorded right away.

If you have more than one bike, bring all of them to the dealership to get read and recorded.

Individual Recognition

Annual recognition program rewards members throughout the year for meeting various milestones. You'll receive a Ride 365 patch and 1,000 mile rocker first, then another rocker for each 5,000 miles recorded! So each time you ride to the dealership, have the service department record your mileage so that we can collectively track the Chapter Mileage progress for the Chapter Challenge as well! Our goal for the 2019 chapter challenge is 500,000 miles! If everyone participates, we can make it happen!

Lifetime Recognition

Our Lifetime mileage leaders to date are Laura Farnsworth with over 170,000 miles and Neale Hanson with over 150,000 miles! Every mile helps so we encourage each of you to participate.

Chapter Recognition

At the end of the year, chapters with the highest total mileage and highest average per member are the winners, who will receive patches, plaques, parties and more!
