I have placed ride sign-up sheets in the chapter book for the next few months, located in the HOG area of the dealership. Please be sure to sign-up so that the Road Captains have an idea of how many bikes they will be leading and roughly how many guests the restaurants should be expecting.

Our first ride of the season will be our April Fool's Ride to South Shore Bar and Grill in Delavan on Sunday, April 7th. Lyle Boss will be leading this ride, Kick Stands Up (KSU) at 11:00 a.m..

Our next ride will be our version of a Pie Ride to the Norske Nook in DeForest on Sunday, April 28th. I will be leading that ride, KSU at 9:30 a.m.. **Please note on your calendars, that this ride was changed from 10:30 KSU to 9:30 KSU!**

Then the rides start becoming more frequent in May

Matt Reckard will be leading a ride on Saturday, May 4th to Bismarck's in Watertown. Matt will also be leading a ride on Saturday and Sunday, May 11th and 12th (**overnight stay**) to JP Cycles Museum in Anamosa, IA. We also have rides scheduled for May 18th and May 25th. More information and reminders regarding these rides will be posted on our Boardtracker HOG Facebook page. Be sure that you are "Following" this page so that you get timely notifications.

Any non-chapter members attending these rides must fill out a waiver prior to each ride, even if a passenger. The solution to avoiding this is each time to join H.O.G National as an Associate Member for \$29/yr and our local chapter for \$20/yr. Associate members do not need to own a Harley or even ride on a bike, they simply need to have a full-member or life-member sponsor.

The Wisconsin H-D Dealers Association Passport Tour Books are now available at the dealership. Get your book stamped at all 17 participating dealers to enter for a chance to win the Grand Prize of \$2,000 and 2 tires installed or 9 other prizes. Details are listed in the books.

Remember to sign up for the HD Ride 365 program to earn mileage rockers and pins. Bring your bike to the dealership ASAP to get your VIN(s) and mileage reading(s) recorded by the Service personnel. Our chapter goal is 500,000 miles as a group, so enter early. And each time you visit, have service advisors update your miles for the Ride 365. You **MUST ASK** for this to be done each time.

The CHAPTER Mileage contest begins on April 7th. Although the dealership will be open on Sundays beginning March 31st, I will be on the April Fools ride and be able to capture your VIN and mileage reading between 10 am and 11 am. If you can't make it on the 7th, get in as soon after to start racking up your mileage credits.

Also please note on your calendars that the Tub Run and the Psycho Silo Rides have swapped dates, so now the Tub Run is on 6/1 and Psycho Silo on 6/22.
