 - ✓ Rs. 1 Lakh for Pre Matric Scholarship.
 - ✓ Rs. 2 Lakh for Post Matric Scholarship.
 - ✓ Rs. 2.5 Lakh for Merit Cum Means Scholarship.
- Student should belong to Karnataka State.
- Students of Karnataka domicile studying in other states are also eligible to apply in Karnataka.
