Judging: Each category will have a one to two, 5 min jam sessions. Each contestant will be judged by.

- 1) Number of Tricks Landed.
- 2) Percent use of Plaza.
- 3) Level of difficulty.
- 4) Overall Style.

MUSIC: There will be a live DJ on site playing music throughout the event. No music may be submitted by participants to play.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be issued.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE: Priority is based upon first come/first served procedure. Participants may be required to show documentation for proof of age. A parent or guardian will be required to sign the registration/hold harmless form for

participants under the age of 18. Participants 18 years and older will be able to sign their own form. There will be no mail-in or phone-in registration.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK
