



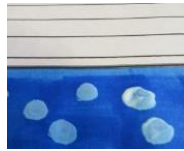
## SNOW ART ACCENTS

Students can use any one or a combination of the following art accents around the border of their writing.

1. Fill the border with snow or winter stickers.



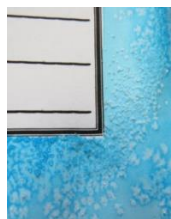
2. Use a blue marker to fill the border. Use a Q-tip and white acrylic paint to dot snow around the blue border.



3. Use white crayon to draw snowflakes around the border. Use purple watercolor paint to fill the border. The snowflakes will show through.



4. Paint the border with blue watercolor paint. Sprinkle salt on the wet blue paint. The salt will crystalize looking like snow.



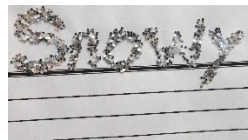
5. Ball up small pieces of foil and glue them around the border. Shape the foil into letters to form a title. Because of the weight of the foil, print the lined story paper on cardstock for this art accent.



6. Use blue marker to fill the border. Stretch balls of cotton as thin as possible. Glue them down onto the blue border.



7. Put drops of Elmer's glue around the border. Spell a title with the Elmer's glue. Shake silver glitter over the Elmer's glue. The glitter will stick to the glue. Shake the remaining glitter off the paper.



8. Use a blue or purple marker to fill the border. Use glitter glue to draw snowflakes around the border. Spell a title using the glitter glue. The glitter glue takes a long time to dry but becomes a nice finish.



9. Use ABC stickers to write a title.
