



## SIGHT WORD SENTENCES LIST 2

Just to recap:

1. Once a child has learned how to spell the words in [LIST 1](#), you can begin teaching him/her how to write and read these sentences.
2. The suggested time for each sentence is 2 weeks, spending one week on vocabulary and the 2<sup>nd</sup> week on the word family. Spend more or less time according to the child's progress.
3. The child should know how to spell all of the SIGHT WORDS in the sentence before moving onto the next sentence. The underline words DO NOT need to be spelled correctly to move on.
4. The underlined words can be replaced with different words to teach vocabulary.
5. The word families are there to teach a specific spelling pattern.

You are my friend.                      Vocabulary: people  
Focus on spelling the word *friend*.

Come with me, Mom.                      Vocabulary: family/names of friends  
Focus on spelling *come* and *with*.

"Come here," I said.                      Vocabulary: family (my mom, my dad...)  
Focus on spelling *here* and *said*. Teach quotation punctuation.

He ate his lunch.                      Vocabulary: foods  
Word family: ate, date, gate, hate, late, mate, plate, state

She ate her meat.                      Vocabulary: foods  
Word family: beat, heat, meat, seat, treat

We went to the store.                      Vocabulary: places  
Word family: bent, dent, rent, sent, tent, went

They came too.                      Vocabulary: past verbs  
Word family: blame, came, flame, frame, game, name, same, tame



We took our map.

Vocabulary: objects

Word family: cap, flap, gap, lap, map, nap, rap, sap, tap, zap

We saw two snakes.

Vocabulary: animals

Focus on spelling the number words *two, six and ten*.

There were four rocks.

Vocabulary: objects

Focus on spelling the number words *four, five and nine*.

They had three cars.

Vocabulary: toys

Focus on spelling the number words *three, seven and eight*

I liked all of the games.

Vocabulary: plural objects

Review the word family: all, ball, call, fall, hall, mall, tall, wall

It was cold.

Vocabulary: weather

Word family: bold, cold, fold, hold, mold, sold, told

It was good.

Vocabulary: adjectives

Focus on spelling the word *good*.
