



## SIGHT WORD SENTENCES LIST 8

Just to recap:

1. Once a child has learned how to spell the sight words in [LIST 7](#), you can begin teaching him/her how to write and read these sentences.
2. **At this point, many children can work on 2-3 sentences per week. You can use one that is listed here, plus two that you create based on words your student misspells in his/her free writing.**
3. The child should know how to spell all of the SIGHT WORDS in the sentence before moving onto the next sentence. The underline words DO NOT need to be spelled correctly to move on.
4. The underlined words can be replaced with different words to teach vocabulary.
5. The word families are there to teach a specific spelling pattern.

Vocabulary: adjectives

Word Family: ow=long o, bow, flow, low, mow, row, show, sow, throw, tow

Don't drive too fast!

Vocabulary: adverbs

Word Family: dive, drive, five, hive, strive, thrive

What kind of dog do you have?

Vocabulary: animals

Word Family: bind, find, hind, kind, mind, rind, wind

It was a beautiful place.

Vocabulary: nouns

Word Family: face, lace, mace, pace, place, race, trace

They lived there for twenty years.

Vocabulary: number words

Word Family: ea=long e, ears, fears, gears, hears, nears,

For vacation, we went to Florida.

Vocabulary: state names (capitalized)

Word Family: tion=sh sound, action, fraction, lotion, motion, potion, nation

The weather by the ocean was cloudy.

Vocabulary: weather

Word Family: feather, Heather, leather, weather

We had a great time even though it was cold.

Vocabulary: weather

Focus on spelling the word **THOUGH**.



We had to wear our jackets.

Vocabulary: clothing

Word Family: ea=long a, bear, pear, tear, wear

It rained the third night that we were there.

Vocabulary: ordinal numbers

Word Family: bright, fight, light, might, plight, right, sight, tight

That's the eighth house that they have built.

Vocabulary: ordinal numbers

Focus on spelling the ordinal numbers 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>

Can you help me make a round cake?

Vocabulary: him, her, us, them, names

Word Family: bound, found, ground, hound, mound, pound, round, sound, wound

We're going to walk through another tunnel.

Vocabulary: nouns

Focus on spelling the word THROUGH.

The cabbage will start to grow in about two weeks. Vocabulary: Vegetables

Word Family: cart, dart, mart, part, start, tart
