NOTE: This overview is written with the idea that the child already knows the names and sounds of each letter A to Z. If your child does not know each letter name and sound, I suggest beginning the steps in my post, [Help Children Learn to Write: 10 Strategic Steps](#). Your child can work on these steps in place of Phonics and Sight Word Sentences.

READING: On Monday, read the pages noted TO your children for enjoyment.

PHONICS: On Monday, talk about the blended sounds and think of words that begin with that blend. Write the words that you think of on a piece of paper. Casually talk about the blend all week long as you come across other words with that same sound.

WRITING: Print and read, [An Easy and On-Going Spelling Strategy](#), Lists [1](#) and [2](#) are below.

MATH: These concepts may be new for your child or too easy. If they are too easy, supplement the activities with other math pages or workbooks.

HISTORY/SCIENCE: Enjoy reading these pages to your children. I alternate between History and Science throughout the year. Complete the suggested activities on each page. If you have time you can find documentaries on Youtube, Netflix or Amazon Prime. You can check out books from the library and/or complete crafts found on [Pinterest](#) to support the concepts your child is learning about.

HIGHLIGHT each section that you complete. Your child may move faster or slower in any one area. Highlighting completed sections helps you keep track of what they have finished and what they still need to do.
