



LONE STAR SHOOTOUT COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Below is the Dallas Lacrosse COVID-19 protocol as we prepare for the 2020 Lone Star Shootout. These guidelines are based on recommendations from the local, state, federal governments and health officials.

Due to the fluid situation, these guidelines may change and a final set of guidelines may be created before the tournament weekend. Any participants or fans who blatantly disregard these guidelines may be subject to removal from the facility.

Dallas Lacrosse nor the City of Lewisville can not ensure that those attending the Lone Star Shootout will not get sick with COVID-19.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

The following guidelines should be followed at all times:

- Do not attend if you feel sick or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
- ANYONE who begins to feel ill on-site, should leave the facility immediately.
- Dallas Lacrosse Staff and Volunteers will wear a mask when social distancing is not possible.
- Dallas Lacrosse reserves the right to take the temperature of anyone on the facility. Anyone with recording a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be asked to leave.
- Players, Fans and Coaches are asked to bring materials to adhere to safety guidelines. i.e. hand sanitizer, masks, their own snacks, and bottled water.
- Masks should be worn when in line at concession, the bathroom, a tournament vendor or when walking around the park.
- Social distancing should be maintained everywhere at the park with the exception of players and coaches on the field.
- No Team Tents - No Gatherings between games.
- Restrooms will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Sanitizer will be available at each field, the concession area and at the Head Quarters trailer.
- People should not touch or handle any tournament supplies or equipment that do not belong to them.
- Should there be a weather delay, players, fans, and coaches are asked to go to their vehicles until further notice.

TEAM SIDELINES

- Only coaches (3) and players are allowed on the bench-side of the field.
- Players will be asked to social distance as much as possible on the sideline
- No post-game line-ups, hand shakes, high-fives, fist bumps or hugs please.

FANS SIDELINES

- Fans will be asked to social distance on the sideline and wear masks.
- Family members are allowed to be within 6 feet of each other.



PLAYERS AND COACHES

- Coaches and players are NOT required to wear masks on the field during games.
- After games, we do ask coaches to conduct team talks with all participants wearing masks.
- Coaches are asked to continually screen players through the weekend.

REFEREES

- Refs are NOT required to wear masks on the field during games.
- Refs will make penalty announcements to the benches from at least 10 yards away

AFTER GAMES

- Teams and fans are asked to leave immediately after their final game is played.
We do not encourage fans or players to stay and watch other games

SEVERE WEATHER

- During a stoppage of play, everyone will go directly to their car in the parking lot.
- Texts and emails will be sent out when it is safe to return to the fields.

WHO SHOULD NOT ATTEND

- If you have a compromised immune system, respiratory issues or diabetes..
- If you are over 65 years of age with underlying health issues.
- If you refuse to wear a mask or social distance from others.
- General lacrosse fans not associated with a player
