Personal Study/Group Discussion.

1. Read Acts 3:1-10
2. The Beggar was asking for money and he was given something completely different. Talk about this interaction. Can you think of an example in your life where you wanted a blessing and God wanted to give you a solution?
3. Silver and Gold we don't have, but what we do have, I give to you!! What is God speaking to you about when it comes to this statement? One example: God's shifts our value system. WHAT ELSE?
4. Peter took him by the right hand and helped him to his feet, what's the significance of this?
5. He walked in jumping and praising God. The intensity of his worship was great because he received more than money but real transformation in his life. What is something deep that you need God to heal, change, transform? Roots over Fruits.
6. Read Acts 3:17-19. Peter said, repent and turn to GOD, He'll wipe out your sin and replace it with a "TIME OF REFRESHING"! Discuss these verses.
7. How have you seen the Holy Spirit work in your life? This man received crazy transformation, most of us have in one way or another. When we talk about what God is doing we are inspired and the bible says, "the devil is overcome by the power of our testimony." So, just as this man jumped and praised the Lord, we need to speak what God has done for us, sometimes we need to remind ourselves and the enemy how good God is and how He has already worked in our lives.
8. Take time to pray for each other and let's ask God to bring root level transformation in our lives.

Continued prayer focus:

1. Pray for God to empower His people for transformation and Growth.
2. That I would live in the middle of God's will and be filled with His power for the common GOOD.
3. Pray that God would continue to reveal Himself to each of us.
4. Pray that God would RENEW the strength of Christ Followers, that He would bring Clarity to His will and miraculous transformation to the American church.
5. Depth of relationship with Jesus. That we would be FILLED with the POWER of the HOLY SPIRIT!!
