EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 2020-2

REGULATIONS FOR ALL EVENTS UTILIZING PUBLIC RESOURCES

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2020, New York State Governor Andrew Cuomo issued Executive Order Number 202, declaring a State disaster emergency for the entire State of New York;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, I, Sage Gerling, City Manager of the City of Geneva, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Director of Public Safety for the City of Geneva by Section 9.1 of Article IX of the Geneva City Charter, ordered until further notice all events approved by the City and/or utilizing public resources be cancelled effective March 13, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Finger Lakes Region and Ontario County, New York continue to meet the New York Forward guidelines for reopening.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Sage Gerling, City Manager of the City of Geneva, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Director of Public Safety for the City of Geneva by Section 9.1 of Article IX of the Geneva City Charter, resume the approval process through the Recreation Department for outdoor event applications submitted prior to March 13, 2020 and begin accepting new applications for outdoor events occurring on or after September 1, 2020. This directive pertains to outdoor events that are approved by the City and/or utilize public resources and include, but are not limited to: block parties; clean-ups; health fairs; mobile units; press conferences; production events; rallies marches; demonstrations; religious events; festivals; parades; concerts; and movies. Applicants must comply with Federal, State and Local laws and regulations including the most current Executive Orders and guidelines from Governor Cuomo due to COVID-19. Applicants will need to develop a New York Forward Safety plan and may need approval from the Ontario County Public Health Department if requested by the City. The continuation of this order will depend on compliance with the Governor Cuomo's Executive Orders and guidelines.
