



Spencer Clark Construction Studies Scholarship

Requirements:

Student must be a graduating high school senior, completed 2 full school years of classroom and lab training in a qualified ACT Program within the school district of Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Volusia county; and completed a minimum of 160 hours of summer OJT (on-the-job training) with an ACT sponsoring employer prior to graduation.

Point Criteria:

1. **Complete and updated resume.** [Worth 10 points](#)
2. **Write an essay: "What I have learned in the construction industry & how it will effect my future goals".**
Essay must be between 150-300 words, typed and double-spaced. [Worth 1-30 points](#)
3. **Complete school transcript, reflecting a minimum 2.0 GPA.** [Worth 1-15 points](#)
4. **Verification of summer OJT hours worked - minimum of 160 hours with ACT sponsoring employer to qualify.** [Worth 1-15 points](#)
5. **Letter of Recommendation from Employer.** [Worth 1-15 points.](#)
6. **Letter of Recommendation from Teacher.** [Worth 1-15 points.](#)

Maximum Points Available 100

Completed Application Deadline is – April 1st, 2017

Employer & Teacher of ACT youth/pre-apprentice can email, fax or mail their recommendation to the ACT office. Recommendations must arrive at the ACT office on or before the deadline date.

ACT Youth/Pre-Apprentice can email, fax or mail their **Resume, Essay, Transcript and verification of OJT** to the ACT office. All information must arrive at the ACT office on or before the deadline date.

There will be one winning recipient from each school district of Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Volusia.

Winning recipient will have two years from date of High School graduation to claim his/her scholarship. Recipient must show proof of enrollment into a post-secondary program that is construction related beyond the withdrawal date of the post-secondary class to receive the scholarship.

This is an unrestricted scholarship. It can be used at the winning recipient's discretion towards books, tools, tuition, etc.

When multiple applications are received within the same school district, the winning recipient will be determined by a selection committee. The selection committee will consist of three (3) people:

Two ACT Board of Trustee members & the Executive Director of ACT.

The selection committee will review the applicants and a decision will be announced at the Graduation Banquet.
